Course Title: Certificate course on Assessment of Prakriti

About Institute:

The National Institute of Ayurveda was established on Feb. 7th, 1976 by the Government of India as an apex Institute of Ayurveda in the country to develop high standard of teaching, training and research in all aspects of Ayurvedic System of Medicine with a scientific approach. Honorable Prime-minister of India declared NIA as Deemed to be University under De Novo category on Nov. 9th, 2020. The NIA, Deemed to be University is NAAC accredited with grade “A” and imparts UG, PG, Ph.D., M Sc. courses, Diploma Course in Ayurveda Nursing and Pharmacy and Certificate courses of different durations. The Institute is engaged in Teaching, Clinical and Research at Under Graduate, Post Graduate and Ph.D. level. Admission to Under Graduate, Post Graduate and Ph.D. level is made on the basis of entrance Examination. The PG Course of MD/MS(Ay.) is available in 14 Specialties, viz. Agad Tantra, Dravya Guna, Kayachikitsa, Kaumar Bhritya, Maulik Siddhanta, Panchkarma, Prasuti Tantra & Stri Roga, Roga & Vikrit Vigyan, Rasa Shastra, Sharir Rachana, Sharir Kriya, Shalya Tantra, Shalakya Tantra and Swastha Vritta. There are two PhD seats available in each Department per year and Diploma in Ayush Nursing and Pharmacy (DAN&P) also running regularly. Various certificate courses also conducted time to time in various Departments. The Institute has a 300 Bedded NABH accredited NIA Hospital, with OPD and a Primary Emergency Care Unit and NABL accredited laboratory. Satellite branches of NIA are at SSBH Kishanpol Bazar, Satellite Hospital in Jawahar Nagar, Satellite Hospital Jamwa Ramgarah, Jaipur. Various specialty Clinics for Skin care, Diabetes, Allergy, Geriatric, Dietary, Child Mental Health and other specialty clinics etc. are also available in the Hospital for specialized consultation and treatment.

About the Course–

The Certificate Course on Assessment of Prakriti is designed to give hands on training on Uniformity and standardized tool used for helping in Ayurvedic diagnosis. The course is designed for people who are emerging physician working in Government or Private sector looking to startup with Prakriti Assessment Clinics. The 30 days Certificate Course on assessment of Prakriti is being offered by NIA, Deemed to be University (De Novo), Jaipur in the Department of Kriya Sharir.

Aim and Objectives of the Course – –

- 1) To prepare Prakriti Analyst.
- 2) To develop co-ordination skill, self-discipline, empathy, dedication, patience, persistence and ethical behavior in trainees.
- 3) To nurture assessment skills like good communication with the Assesses.
- 4) To collect the information from assesses and prepare the Prakriti report based on outcome evaluation.

Type of the Course – 30 days Certificate course will be a contact learning programme with hands on training and periodical assessments of the participants.

Duration: 30 days

Eligibility: BAMS Graduates

Intake capacity: 20 students per batch (For two batches)

Fees: No fee as it is a Sponsored Programme from Ministry of AYUSH, Govt. of India (under Central Sector Scheme for Skill Development under Champion Services Sector Scheme).

Selection Procedure: On first come first serve basis of the eligible candidates.

Medium of Instruction: English and Hindi

Certificate: Regular assessments will be done throughout the programme. Certificate will be provided to the trainees after clearing the Exit exam with minimum 50% marks.

Certificates will be awarded to the qualified students by the Institute.

General Rules and Regulations: As per the rules and regulations of NIA, Deemed to be university (de-novo), Jaipur guidelines.

Hostel facility: No hostel facility shall be provided by NIA for the students enrolling for this certificate course.

Financial Assistance: INR. 9000 only per student after the completion of the training program and obtaining completion certificate.
