Course Title:

Certificate Course in *Striroga Sthanika Chikitsa*

Brief Introduction:

Majority of the gynecological disorders are local in nature and needs to be treated at in-situ i.e. vaginal canal, cervix, uterus etc. Systemic treatments provided by the general practitioners often failed to produce complete cure in cases of simple vaginitis, pelvic inflammatory disease, leucorrhoea, cervical erosion, fallopian tube blockage, bacterial vaginosis, bartholin abscess, genital prolapse, uterine fibroids, adenomyosis, endometriosis etc. Majority of the times, leaving unattended, and these simple problems lead to chronic diseases, recurrence, finally sometimes end in malignancy. In contrast, Ayurveda has a lot to offer for the complete cure of these conditions through its various local/in-situ therapies. *Sthanika chikitsa* or in-situ treatments are minimal invasive procedures which are found safe, efficacious and economical methods for treating various gynecological diseases like *Yonivyapad* (diseases of female reproductive system), *Artavavyapad* (menstrual disorders), *Vandhyatwa* (Infertility) etc. Keeping the necessity in view a 45 days *Striroga Sthanika chikitsa* Certificate Course is being offered by P.G. Department of *Prasutitantra* and *Striroga*, National Institute of Ayurveda. This course is specially designed for Ayurvedic graduates, Practitioners, Medical Officers, Ayurvedic teachers and Researchers.

Aim:

To provide applied knowledge of in-situ procedures like *Yoniprakshalana*, *Yonipichu*, *Ksharakarma*, *Agnikarma*, *Yonipottali*, *Yoni kalkadharana*, *Sthanika Snehana* and *Swedana*, *Yonivarti*, *Yonipralepa*, *Yonidhupan*, *Matrabasti*, *Madhutailika basti*, *Niruha basti* and *Uttarabasti* in the management of gynecological diseases.

Objectives:

1. Teaching of theoretical principles of *Sthanika chikitsa*

2. Provide training on preparation of materials required for *Sthanika chikitsa*
3. Provide hands on training of *Sthanika chikitsa* procedures

Type of the course:

This 45 days Certificate course is a learning programme with hands on training followed by periodical assessment.

Duration: 45 days

Eligibility: BAMS Graduates

Intake capacity: 20 students per batch (Two Batches)

Fees: No fee as it is a Sponsored Programme from Ministry of AYUSH, Govt. of India (under Central Sector Scheme for Skill Development under Champion Services Sector Scheme).

Selection Procedure: On first come first serve basis of the eligible candidates.

Medium of Instruction: English and Hindi

Certificate: 3 assessments will be done after every 15 days. Certificate will be provided to the trainees after completion of the course.

Theory and Practical Examinations will be conducted after completion of the course. Minimum Passing Marks in Theory as well in Practical will be 50%. Certificates will be awarded to the qualified students by the Institute.

General Rules and Regulations: As per the rules and regulations of NIA.

Hostel facility: No hostel facility shall be provided by NIA for the students enrolling for this certificate course.

Financial Assistance: Rs. 9000/- per student after the completion of the training program and obtaining completion certificate.
