INSTRUCTIONS FOR CANDIDATES GOING TO PARTICIPATE IN NIADU-PG COUNSELING 2024 FOR MD/MS (AYU) COURSES 2024 -25

All the candidates going to participate in NIADU-PG counseling 2024 who have registered themselves as PwBD candidates/OBC NCL/ EWS/SC/ST candidates at NTA website during registration for AIAPGET-2024 examination and want to avail benefits of reservation in National Institute of Ayurveda, Jaipur (MD/MS) Courses are advised to prepare and upload their respective PwBD/OBC NCL/EWS/SC/ST Certificate as per prescribed format during registration and bring original certificate at reporting.

1. **NOTE: OBC NCL & Economically Weaker Section (GEN-EWS) certificate must be issued on or after 1 April 2024 by the Competent Authority. . If any candidate failed to upload the valid certificates, He/She will ineligible for the admission in MD/MS (Ayu.) courses for session 2024-25.**
 - i. The Candidate should prepare/obtain the following certificate, if applicable:
 - a) **Disability Certificate** issued from a duly constituted and authorized Medical Board for 21 Benchmark Disabilities as per the Rights of Persons with Disability Act, 2016, will be accepted. The format of the Certificate of Disability is attached as **Annexure-I**. No other PwD certificate issued by any other Authorities/ Hospital will be accepted. (The qualified candidates with Benchmark Disability (PwBD)- should get themselves certified at one of the Disability Assessment Boards, constituted in various States/UTs. The list of authorized designated Centers that will issue Disability Certificates as per 21 Benchmark Disabilities given under RPwD Act-2016 is attached as **Annexure-II**)
 - b) **SC/ST Certificate** issued by the competent authority, and it should be either in English or Hindi. Sub-caste should be mentioned in the certificate and tally with the respective central list of corresponding states published by the Government of India (<https://socialjustice.gov.in/common/76750>) and (<https://tribal.nic.in/Knowledge Hub.aspx>). The certificate should be **as per the prescribed format** of the Government of India (**Annexure -III**).
 - c) **OBC-NCL certificate** issued by the Competent Authority (**issued on or after 1 April 2024**) **as per the prescribed format** of the Government of India. The sub-caste in the OBC-NCL certificate should tally with the updated Central List of OBC <http://www.ncbc.nic.in>. The OBC-NCL certificate format is attached as **Annexure-IV**.

- d) **Economically Weaker Section (GEN-EWS) certificate issued on or after 1 April 2024** by the Competent Authority. **(Annexure-V)**

NOTE:

2. If there is a spelling discrepancy between the Certificates and the application/registration form/provisional allotment letter, the candidate must carry an affidavit/undertaking to prove that the documents belong to the same person.
3. All the candidates are advised to upload the valid documents as per prescribed format while doing registration for admission in MD/MS (Ayu.) courses in National Institute of Ayurveda, Jaipur. Without valid certificates (Caste/PwBD Certificate etc.) the candidate will not be considered for selection/admission in any scenario. If any candidate failed to upload the valid certificates, HE/SHE will be responsible for his/her disqualification for selection/admission in MD/MS (Ayu.) courses for session 2024-25.
