At the outset, the Chairperson welcomed the members. He apprised the council about the successful organization of the Golden Jubilee & informed about the visit of the Hon'ble Chief Minister of Rajasthan, Hon'ble Union Minister of State (Independent Charge) for Ayush, Shri Prataprao Jadhav, Hon'ble Deputy Chief Minister of Rajasthan, Hon'ble Chief Secretary Government of Rajasthan & Hon'ble Secretary Ayush, GOI & Hon'ble Principal Secretary (Higher Education), Government of Rajasthan on 4th to 9th January 2026.

The Chairperson also briefed the members on the various events organized as part of the Golden Jubilee celebrations. Further, the members were apprised of the announcement made by the Hon'ble Chief Minister of Rajasthan regarding the allocation of land to the institution for its future expansion, along with the proceedings initiated in this regard.

Chairperson also shared the **Details about the Unveiling, Inaugurations, Launchings & the Memoranda of Understanding (MoUs) signed on the Occasion of the Golden Jubilee Celebrations.**

The Chairperson also informed the members about the creation of posts for NIA, Panchkula, and apprised them of the proceedings initiated regarding the lease agreement for acquiring the *Dharmshala-Bhavan of Mandir Shri Baldev Ji Parshuram Dwara*, Amer Road, Jaipur, for the establishment of the Panchkarma Centre.

Following the opening remarks, and with the permission of the Chair, Prof. Narinder Singh, on behalf of Prof. (Dr.) Anita Sharma, Secretary, Executive Council, proceeded to present the agenda proposals for discussion, consideration, and approval.

Agenda Item No. EC. 4.1	Confirmation of the Minutes of 3rd Meeting of the Executive Council held on January 17th, 2026
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The Executive Council was informed that the Minutes of its 3rd Meeting held on 17th January, 2026 had been circulated to all the esteemed members. The observations received from the members regarding Agenda Item Nos. EC.3.5, EC.3.6, EC.3.13, EC.3.16, EC.3.17 and EC.3.18 were duly considered and appropriately incorporated in the Minutes.

The revised Minutes were circulated to the members vide letter No. F.1(04) EC/REG/NIA/2026/92 dated 17th February, 2026. No further comments were received thereafter. After due deliberation, the Executive Council confirmed the Minutes of its 3rd Meeting

Agenda Item No. EC. 4.2	Action Taken Report (ATR) and Current Status of Implementation of the Decisions Taken in the 2nd Meeting of the Executive Council
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The Executive Council was informed that the decisions taken during its 3rd Meeting held on 17th January, 2026 had been duly implemented and were being followed. The Council discussed, thoroughly reviewed, and took note of the Action Taken Report and the current status of implementation of the decisions taken in the said meeting. During the discussion, the following observations were made:

1. **Agenda Item No. EC 3.5;** Visit of Hon'ble Chief Secretary, Government of Rajasthan): Chairperson sought clarification regarding the current status of sharing the compiled document containing details of research, publications, and the Institute's best practices with the office of the Hon'ble Chief Secretary and other relevant State authorities. He instructed the Dean, Research to communicate the list to the Chief Secretary, Rajasthan.
2. **Agenda Item No. EC 3.6;** The Council while discussing reg. *Ayurveda Aahar* recommended to explore manufacturing of "*Pathyakalpana*" as required for hospital IPD and to promote it across all Ayush hospitals of the country. The Advisor (Ayurveda) enquired that if any update on the identification of any *Kalpana* for commercial production is made till date. He also advised that this initiative be expedited as a priority. Consequently, the Council was informed that the Hospital of NIA has already collaborated with the Deptt. of Ras Shashtra & BK in order to develop "*Pathyakalpana*" for "*Purvakarma & Paschatkarma*". The proceedings are in progress & in near future the detailed report regarding this would be presented & shared to other Ayush Hospitals.

3. **Agenda Item No. EC 3.19** (Commencement of the Diploma Course in Panchakarma at NIA, Panchkula and B.Pharmacy and M.Pharmacy courses at NIA, Deemed to be University, Jaipur): It was suggested that the draft policy and curricular framework be placed before the Finance Committee and other relevant statutory bodies for necessary approvals so that the courses may be commenced at the earliest.

Agenda Item No. EC. 4.3	Information Regarding the Recent Visit of the Hon'ble Chief Minister of Rajasthan and the Hon'ble Union Minister of State (Independent Charge) for Ayush, Shri Prataprao Jadhav
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The Executive Council took note of the visit of the Hon'ble Chief Minister of Rajasthan, Shri Bhajan Lal Sharma, and the Hon'ble Union Minister of State (Independent Charge) for Ayush, Shri Prataprao Jadhav, to the Institute on 9th February, 2026.

The members noted that the visit played a significant role in recognizing and validating the Institution's contributions to society, education, and the economy at both national and international levels. The visit also provided an opportunity for the Institute to showcase its glorious journey of the last 50 years, including its contributions, innovations, and the ground-level challenges being faced, directly before the policymakers.

The members also took note of the announcements made, unveilings, inaugurations and the Memoranda of Understanding (MoUs) signed on the occasion of the Golden Jubilee Celebrations.

Agenda Item No. EC. 4.4	Briefing on the Sanction of ₹ 2 Crore for the Golden Jubilee Year Celebrations Commemorating the Foundation Day
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The Executive Council noted the approval for expenditure of ₹2 Crore from the sanctioned budget for organizing the events and programmes in connection with the Golden Jubilee Celebrations held from 4th to 9th February, 2026. The Council further noted that all expenditures were incurred in accordance with the terms and conditions prescribed by the Department of Expenditure, Ministry of Finance.

Agenda Item No. EC. 4.5	Report on the Golden Jubilee Year Celebrations Commemorating the Foundation Day of NIA, Jaipur
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The Executive Council took note of the Golden Jubilee Celebrations organized as the Foundation Day celebration on 7th February, 2026. The occasion was graced by several eminent dignitaries, including the Hon'ble Secretary, Ministry of Ayush, Government of India, former Directors of the Institute, administrative authorities, former and present faculty members, alumni, students, and staff.

The members noted that the event served as a significant milestone, commemorating the institution's illustrious 50-year legacy while also strengthening its vision for future growth in the areas of evidence-based healthcare, research, and academic excellence.

In this context, the Executive Council also took note of the pre-conference and conference "SHALYACON-2026" organized from 4th to 7th February, 2026 as part of the Golden Jubilee Celebrations. The main conference witnessed participation from over 120 resource persons and more than 650 delegates from across India and neighboring countries. The event provided an important platform for the future generation of professionals to engage in learning, exchange of experiences, and discussion of new ideas and innovations. It also included intensive hands-on training workshops and demonstrations of over 80 live surgical procedures conducted from the newly integrated Modular Operation Theatre of the Institute

Agenda Item No. EC. 4.6	Information Regarding the Submission of the DPR for Allotment of Land to the Principal Secretary, Department of Ayush, Government of Rajasthan
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In pursuance to the announcement and directions of the Hon'ble Chief Minister of Rajasthan during the Institute's Golden Jubilee Celebrations, the Executive Council took note of the submission of the Detailed Project Report (DPR) for land allotment to the Principal Secretary, Department of Ayush, Government of Rajasthan. The Chairperson further informed the Council that several land options had already been surveyed, and once a decision is finalized, the land allotment process is expected to be completed within a target period of six month.

Agenda Item No. EC. 4.7	Information Regarding the Lease Transfer of Dharmshala-Bhavan of Mandir Shri Baldev Ji Parshuram Dwara, Amer Road, Jaipur to the National Institute of Ayurveda, Jaipur for Establishment of a Panchakarma Centre
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The Executive Council considered and took note of the progress in the proceedings initiated for the lease agreement to acquire the Dharmshala-Bhavan of Mandir Shri Baldev Ji Parshuram Dwara for the establishment of the Panchakarma Centre. The Council also reviewed the terms of the lease agreement and recommended obtaining the longest possible lease period to justify the substantial investment needed for developing the state-of-the-art Panchakarma infrastructure.

Agenda Item No. EC. 4.8	Information Regarding the Notification on Creation of 39 Regular Posts for NIA, Panchkula Issued by the Ministry of Ayush, Government of India
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The Executive Council reviewed the creation of 39 teaching and non-teaching posts for NIA, Panchkula. These positions were approved by the Ministry of Finance, as outlined in the Ministry of Ayush letter L-12011/17/2021-AS (dated 13.01.2026).

The Council noted the structure of the committee constituted to oversee different issues regarding this matter. After due deliberation, it was suggested that, to implement the reservation roster for the sanctioned posts in accordance with Government of India norms, the committee should be reconstituted & include a domain expert to implement the reservation roster and a legal expert. The Council further recommended convening an urgent meeting of the Executive Council to consider and approve the recommendations of the Expert Committee at the earliest.

Agenda Item No. EC. 4.9	Information Regarding the Registration of the Memorandum of Association (MoA) with the Registrar, Institutions, Rajasthan
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The Executive Council acknowledged and appreciated the efforts of the concerned authorities in registering the Memorandum of Association (MoA) with the Office of the Registrar, Institutions, Jaipur (Rajasthan), in accordance with the UGC (Deemed to be Universities) Regulations, 2023.

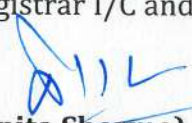

Agenda Item No. EC. 4.12	Industry Exposure of PG scholars for having the collaboration/linkage with industry
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Dr. Kousthubha Upadhyaya, Advisor (Ayurveda), Ministry of Ayush referred the recent Webinar "Sabka Saath, Sabka Vikas Fulfilling Aspirations of People" Topic "Education, Skills and University Townships" chaired by Hon'ble Prime Minister who suggested that there should be Industry Exposure for PG scholars of all departments for collaboration with Industry. The major objectives is to enhance the employability of students, focus on outcome based learning, promote active linkage between higher educational institutions and industries and bridge the skill gap in the industries.

After thorough deliberation, the Executive Council recommended that students must submit a project report upon completion of their industry exposure or visit. The Council emphasized that all requisite arrangements be expedited and necessary procedural formalities be initiated in a timely manner, so as to enable commencement of the above-mentioned Industry exposure at the earliest.

The meeting ended with the vote of thanks from Prof. (Dr.) Anita Sharma, Registrar I/C and Secretary, Executive Council.
