



Agenda Item No. EC.5.1 Consideration of the Committee Report outlining the Recruitment Rules, Faculty Reservation Roster and Post Allocation in reference to the Notification regarding Creation of 39 Regular Posts for NIA Panchkula.

At the outset, Chairman welcomed all the Members of the Executive Council and stated the urgency of the Meeting to discuss and consider certain issues relating to Recruitment to 39 teaching and Non-Teaching Posts recently sanctioned by the Govt. of India for NIA Panchkula. Chairman, in a brief, told about the recruitments of Teaching and Non-Teaching Posts already made to NIA Panchkula and about the newly created Posts.

The issues to be discussed, considered and approved in the present Meeting related to Distribution of the 6 Posts of Assistant Professor among Departments, Identification of the Stream of the 1 Post of Nursing Officer, Adoption of Recruitment Rules for the newly created Posts, Relaxation in PG Experience for the Posts of Professor and Associate Professor and Reservation among the 14 Posts of Professor and Associate Professor.

Chairman informed the Executive Council that for examining and recommending on the above issues, a Committee consisting of the following was constituted.

The Committee met on 13-3-2026 and submitted its recommendations on the above issues which was circulated to Members of the Executive Council. After detailed deliberations and considerations on the issues, the Executive Council approved as follows, on each issue:

1. Distribution of the 6 Posts of Assistant Professor among Departments:

The Executive Council discussed the recommendations made by the Committee and approved that the newly created 6 Posts of Assistant Professors may be distributed among the following 06 Departments, which are needed and required for these Departments:

1. Panchakarma
2. Rachana Sharira
3. Samhita, Siddhant & Sanskrit
4. Shalaky Tantra
5. Stree Roga-Prasuti Tantra
6. Swasthvritta & Yoga

2. Identifying the Stream of Nursing Officer

Executive Council reviewed the status of the Posts of Nursing Officer including the one already filled in one stream. Executive Council decided that the two posts should be in separate streams for the smooth management of the Hospital and Patient Care activities, and therefore, the present Post created may be filled in the other stream.

3. RRs to be adopted in respect of all the Posts

Executive Council noted that uniformity in the recruitments and staff pattern etc. is to be maintained among NIA Jaipur and NIA Panchkula, as reiterated by Ministry. It was, therefore, decided that the Recruitment Rules framed for similar Posts in NIA Jaipur may be adopted for making Recruitments to the Teaching and Non-Teaching Posts of NIA Panchkula.

4. Reservations on the 14 Posts of Professor and 14 Posts of Associate Professor

The Executive Council held detailed deliberations on the issue of Reservations to be applied to the newly created 14 Posts of Professor and 14 Posts of Associate Professor. In this regard, Executive Council was informed about constituting a Committee to examine and suggest Reservations to these Posts.

The Executive Council went through the Report of the Committee. However, referring to the Report, the Executive Council was pointed out about a typographical mistake in the Option 1, indicating Alphabetical Order of Nomenclatures against the Posts of Associate Professor in Col.4 and indicating Schedule IV against the Posts of Professor in Col.5, whereas it is vice-versa. This was clarified before the Executive Council, in detail. Executive Council directed that this may be corrected in Option 1, as clarified.

After detailed discussions, Executive Council approved Option 1, as clarified above, and thus the 14 Posts of Associate Professor may be filled as per Schedule IV of NCISM and the 14 Posts of Professor may be filled as per Alphabetical Order of the Subjects, as given in Option 1 attached herewith as Annexure.


5. One Time Relaxation in PG Experience for the Posts of Associate Professor and Professor

After detailed deliberations, the Executive Council approved a One-Time Relaxation in the Post-Graduate Teaching Experience prescribed in the Recruitment Rules for the 14 Posts of Associate Professor and 14 Posts of Professor. This will enable candidates without the stipulated PG Teaching Experience also to apply for these Posts. Executive Council also suggested that preference may be given to candidates having PG Experience, if available, and found suitable by the Selection Committees.

Executive Council, therefore, approved that Recruitments to the newly created 39 Teaching and Non-Teaching Posts may be made as per its above approvals.

Executive Council also decided that Action Taken Report in respect of the last Meeting may be submitted in the next Meeting.

The Meeting ended with a Vote of Thanks to the Chair.
