Important notices to the candidates

- 1. The candidate has to come with the printed copy of the admit card with his/her color passport size photo pasted in the prescribed place for getting entry to the entrance test.
- 2. In case any eligible candidate (whose name is in the list) is not able to download or print the admit card, then they can appear in the screening test by getting a duplicate Admit card at the venue between 8.00 to 9.00 AM on 08.09.2024 by producing a valid ID card.
- 3. Candidates should report for the Screening Test 1 Hour before the Test along with the Admit Card and also Proof of Identity like Aadhar Card, Voter ID Card, Driving License etc. withoutwhich they will not be permitted to appear in the Test.
- 4. Merit List will be prepared as per the marks obtained in the screening test.
- 5. First Three candidates in the merit list will be called for interview for each seat.
- 6. Separate merit list will be prepared for all branches.
- 7. Weightage for written test will be 70% and that of interview will be 30%.
- 8. Final result will be combined weightage of written test and interview.
- 9. Each question shall consist of 1 mark for each right answer one mark will be awarded whereas for each wrong answer ¼ (one fourth) mark shall be deducted.
- 10. The interview will also consider following aspects-
 - To evaluate the research aptitude of the applicants.
 - The candidate possesses the competence for the proposed research.
 - The research work can be suitably undertaken at the Institution/College.
 - The proposed area of research can contribute to new/additional knowledge.
- 11. Grievances regarding question paper, if any can be submitted on or before 08.09.2024, 5.00 PMat our office as per prescribed procedure, format and fees (will be available on our website from 26.06.2022). No grievance shall be entertained after this time.
- 12. The result, merit list and list for shortlisted candidates for interview will be displayed in the notice board and website of the institute by 6.00 pm on the next day of screening test.
- 13. The candidates are advised to check the notice board and website themselves to know about the result. No individual communication about result and short listing for interview shall be sent to any candidate.
