#### GUIDELINES FOR P.G. & M.SC PROGRAM GUIDE AND PH.D. SUPERVISOR ALLOTMENT

As per the recommendations of the constituted committee, the guidelines for the allocation of supervisor for the Ph.D. program & guide for PG & M.Sc. program are as under:

Ph. D. Programme: Allocation of supervisor must be decided based upon under mentioned guidelines -

- a) Merit of the student in the screening test
- b) Option of the student
- c) Available vacancy under eligible supervisors
- d) Consent of the supervisor

The existing rules & regulations of the UGC Guidelines can be mended as per requirement for the equitable allocation of Ph.D. supervisor at the Department level with mutual consent & understanding.

#### PG & M.Sc. IDS Programme (Guide allocation)

A list of departmental faculties eligible to become PG and M.Sc. guides according to seniority would be drawn. One student will be allocated based on their merit for admission with the sequence starting from the senior most teacher till the junior most eligible guide. The sequence will then repeat for all eligible guides. In subsequent years, guide allocation would commence from the next senior eligible guide and proceed sequentially.

Guidelines can be mended as per requirement for the equitable allocation of P.G. & M.Sc. (IDS) guide ship at the Department level with mutual consent & understanding.
