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The meeting commenced with a warm and ceremonious welcome extended to all dignitaries present. The Chairperson acknowledged the former nominated members in recognition of their valuable contributions and dedicated services rendered to the institution upon completion of their one-year tenure. Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, Prof. (Dr.) Sanjeev Sharma warmly welcomed and introduced all the newly nominated Ex-officio members to other members of Executive Council.

The Chairperson greeted all on the occasion of World Environment Day and highlighted the significance of the day in alignment with Ayurveda philosophy. He emphasized the collective responsibility of the institution towards environmental protection and sustainability. He urged all members to adopt eco-friendly practices in their daily lives and contribute actively towards building a cleaner, greener, and healthier environment.

The Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor congratulated the gathering about the extension of the Deemed-to-be-University status of NIA, Jaipur beyond Nov. 8th, 2025 based on the recommendations of the UGC, and the approval of the Ministry of Education, Government of India, for establishment of the Off-Campus Centre of NIA (DU), Jaipur at Panchkula, Haryana. The Council was also apprised of the creation of 19 posts for the NIA (DU) Jaipur, the ongoing recruitment process, and the proposed initiation of approval procedures for commencement of Postgraduate programmes.

The Executive Council noted the developments with appreciation and congratulated the Institute on these significant achievements.

Following the opening remarks, and with the permission of the Chair, Prof. Narinder Singh, on behalf of Prof. (Dr.) Anita Sharma, Secretary, Executive Council, proceeded to present the agenda proposals for discussion, consideration, and approval.

Agenda Item No. EC. 6.1	Confirmation of the Minutes of 4th & 5th Meeting of the Executive Council held on March 10th & April 6th, 2026 respectively
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It was informed that the Minutes of the 4th & 5th Meeting of the Executive Council were circulated to all the esteemed members dated 25th March, 2026 & 17th April, 2026 respectively. No comments/observations were received from any member. After due deliberation, the Executive Council confirmed the Minutes of its 4th & 5th Meeting.

Dr. Kousthubha Upadhyaya observed that certain technical observations pertaining to the "Centre of Excellence in *Dravyaguna*" project under the *Ayurswasthya Yojana* (Agenda Item 4.3) had not been incorporated in the Minutes of the Meeting. The Chairperson took note of the observation and directed the Registrar's Office to correspond with the Head, Department of *Dravyaguna*, to facilitate the incorporation of the said observations into the Minutes.

Agenda Item No. EC. 6.2	Action Taken Report (ATR) of the Decisions Taken in the 4th & 5th Meeting of the Executive Council
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The Executive Council was informed that the decisions taken during its 4th & 5th Meeting of the Executive Council held on March 10th & April 6th, 2026 respectively had been duly implemented and were being followed.

The Council discussed, thoroughly reviewed, and took note of the Action Taken Report and the current status of implementation of the decisions taken in the said meeting. During the discussion, the following observations were made:

1. **Agenda Item No. EC 3.19** (Commencement of the Diploma Course in Panchakarma at NIA, Panchkula and B. Pharma and M. Pharma courses at NIA, Jaipur):
 - a. The Council was informed that syllabus of Diploma Course in Panchkarma has been finalized and the course will be commenced from the next academic session.
 - b. It was suggested that the committee constituted for drafting the curricular framework of the B.Pharm and M.Pharm programmes in Ayurveda may also be entrusted with the additional responsibility of determining the admission policy, eligibility criteria, intake capacity, and other associated aspects of the programmes.
 - c. The Chairperson emphasized that the B.Pharm (Ayu.) may be commenced from the ongoing academic session. For that the Admission Schedule should be framed expeditiously and admission advertisement may be issued accordingly.
2. **Agenda Item No. EC 4.11** (SEVA Guidelines for Clinicians – NIA Hospitals): The Chairperson directed the office of the Registrar to convene a meeting with all faculty members after the summer vacation. The meeting, to be chaired by him, will include a brief presentation on the SEVA Guidelines with the objective of sensitizing clinicians to ethical practices and reinforcing their moral and professional adherence to these guidelines.

Agenda Item No. EC. 6.3	Information regarding extension of 'Deemed to be University' status of NIA, Jaipur beyond November 8th, 2025
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The Executive Council took note of the extension of the "Deemed to be University" status of NIA, Jaipur beyond 08.11.2025, which had originally been granted for a provisional period of five years, pursuant to the notification No.9/3/2018-U.3 (A) Dated: 30th March, 2026 issued by the Ministry of Education, Government of India on the recommendations of the UGC.

Agenda Item No. EC. 6.4	Information regarding approval for establishment of Off-Campus Centre of NIA (DU), Jaipur at Panchkula, Haryana
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The Executive Council noted the approval accorded by the Ministry of Education, Government of India, vide Notification No. 10-5/2025-U.3(A) dated 12th May, 2026, for the establishment of an Off-Campus Centre of the National Institute of Ayurveda (Deemed to be University), Jaipur at Mata Mansa Devi Complex, Panchkula, Haryana as recommended by the UGC.

Agenda Item No. EC. 6.5	Information regarding the recent Advertisement Vacancy Notification No. 1/2026 for the various recruitment at NIA, Panchkula & NIA, Jaipur
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The Executive Council took note of the information regarding the Recruitment Vacancy Notification No. 1/2026 dated 6th May, 2026 issued by the Institute inviting applications for appointment against various teaching, non-teaching, administrative and technical posts for NIA, Jaipur and NIA, Panchkula.

Note: Dr. Kousthubha Upadhyaya brought to the notice of the Council that a representation regarding the revision of the maximum age limit for the post of Assistant Professor under the aforesaid advertisement had been received in the Ministry with regard to restriction of entry age to 40 years while the same being 45 years in respect of other organisations under the Ministry like AIIA, New Delhi, NIH (Kolkata), NEIAH (Shillong) and NEIFMR (Phasighat). Upon detailed deliberations, Council resolved that the representation will be considered by the Institute and appropriate action by the competent authority in consultation with the the Ministry shall be taken.

Agenda Item No. EC. 6.6	Information regarding the Notification for Creation of 19 Regular Posts for NIA, Jaipur
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The Executive Council took note of the creation of 19 posts for NIA, Panchkula, as approved by the Department of Expenditure, Ministry of Finance, Government of India, vide I.D. No. 11(2)/AYUSH/ECI/2026 dated 15th May, 2026. It was also directed to draft the cabinet note for creation of remaining posts on hold as instructed by the aforesaid letter.

The Executive Council deliberated on the preparation of Recruitment Rules (RRs) and Reservation Rosters for the 18 regular teaching posts approved under the Faculty of Interdisciplinary Studies. In view of the urgency of initiating the recruitment process, the Council emphasized the need for their early finalization.

After detailed deliberations, the Council resolved to constitute a committee of domain experts from the concerned faculty to draft the Recruitment Rules for the sanctioned posts in accordance with the UGC Regulations governing interdisciplinary programme. The Committee shall also examine and recommend revisions to the maximum age limit prescribed for the post of Assistant Professor.

The Council further resolved to constitute a separate committee comprising domain experts and the Legal Advisor to prepare the Reservation Roster for the 18 regular posts in conformity with the prevailing Government of India norms.

Agenda Item No. EC. 6.7	Information regarding the Implementation of amendment made in the Eligibility Criteria of Ph.D. Entrance Examination & the proceedings undertaken thereafter
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The Executive Council considered and took note of the amendment to the eligibility criteria of the Ph.D. Entrance Examination, permitting candidates who have appeared in the final year examination of MD/MS (Ayu.) to apply and appear provisionally for the said examination, subject to the prescribed conditions.

Agenda Item No. EC. 6.9	Approval for Naming the Auditorium at National Institute of Ayurveda after Late Shri Vaidya Prabudutt Ji Shastri
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The Executive Council considered the proposal for naming the auditorium of the National Institute of Ayurveda, Jaipur after Late Vaidya Prabhudatt Ji Shastri. After due deliberation, the Council resolved to constitute a committee to undertake a factual and archival verification of his contributions towards the establishment, advancement and overall development of the Institute. The Committee shall also recommend criteria for naming Government facilities as memorials, after reviewing the relevant protocols and guidelines prescribed by statutory bodies.

Agenda Item No. EC. 6.10	Approval for Commencement of Postgraduate (PG) Programme at NIA, Panchkula
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The Executive Council reviewed and accorded in-principle approval to the proposal for commencement of the Postgraduate Programme at the National Institute of Ayurveda, Panchkula, subject to obtaining requisite approvals from the concerned statutory authorities and competent bodies. The Council further directed that necessary action be initiated and expedited on priority for obtaining the required approvals to facilitate the timely commencement of the programme.

Agenda Item No. EC. 6.11	Approval to Commence Doctor of Literature/Doctor of Science (D.Litt./D.Sc.) Programme at NIA (DU), Jaipur
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The Executive Council principally approved the commencement of the Doctor of Literature/Doctor of Science (D.Litt./D.Sc.) programme as recommended by the committee constituted for the said purpose.

Agenda Item No. EC. 6.12	The Proposal to Increase the Seat Matrix by 05 Seats per Department for the M.Sc. (Interdisciplinary Studies) Programme at NIA (DU), Jaipur
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After detailed deliberations, the Executive Council reviewed and principally approved the proposal for enhancement of the existing intake capacity of the M.Sc. Programme under the Faculty of Interdisciplinary Studies (IDS) from two (2) to five (5) seats per department, subject to obtaining the requisite approval from the competent authorities.

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The Executive Council considered and accepted the recommendations of the 17th Meeting of the Finance Committee held on 25th March, 2026 and circulated vide NIA's letter dated 17.04.2026, thereby authorizing their formal implementation.

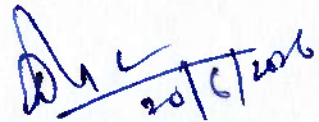

Agenda Item No. EC. 6.15	Constitution of Committee for Conservation, Development, and Ecological Enhancement of Herbal Garden (<i>Dhanvantari Upvan</i>)
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The Executive Council deliberated upon the conservation, ecological enhancement, and sustainable development of the Institute's herbal garden (*Dhanvantari Upvan*). After detailed discussions, the Council resolved to constitute a committee comprising relevant subject experts and administrative officers to guide its environmental preservation, scientific development.

The Committee shall meet periodically and provide recommendations for landscape planning, maintenance, conservation, and the cultivation and preservation of endemic and medicinal flora of Rajasthan, with a view to strengthening the ecological, educational, and research value of *Dhanvantari Upvan*.

The meeting ended with the vote of thanks from Prof. (Dr.) Anita Sharma, Registrar I/C and Secretary, Executive Council.
