**Subject:- Grant of Conditional Permission to National Institute of Ayurveda, (Deemed to be University), Madhav Vilas Palace Amer Road, Jaipur-302002, Rajasthan, (Inst. ID-AYU0225) with 100 seats (125 seats including EWS) in UG (BAMS) Course and 104 Seats (130 seats including EWS) in 14 PG Course namely i). Agad Tantra avum Vidhi Vaidyaka- 06 seats (07 seats including EWS), ii). Prasuti & Stri Roga-07 seats (09 seats including EWS), iii). Dravyaguna Vigyana-09 seats (11 seats including EWS), iv). Kaumarbhritiya - Bala Roga- 07 seats (08 seats including EWS), v). Kayachikitsa-09 seats (11 seats including EWS), vi). Kriya Sharir-08 seats (10 seats including EWS), vii). Sir/Madam,

With reference to the subject mentioned above, I am directed to inform you that in pursuance of the provision of National commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020, the Indian Medicine Central Council Act,1970 (48 of 1970) has been repealed with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021. With effect from the said date, the Central Council of Indian Medicine constituted under sub-division (1) of section 3 of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) shall stand dissolved. Now, In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (3) of the section 1 of the said Act, the Central Government hereby notifies that all the provisions of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020 has been come into force with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021 and as per regulation 59 (2) of The National Commission for Indian System of Medicine ACT, 2020, Medical standards, requirements and other provisions of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 and the rules and regulations made there under shall continue to be in force and operate till new standards or requirements are specified under this Act or the rules and regulations made there under.

Further, the provision of concerned regulations which are inconsistent with the provision of NCISM Act, 2020 shall not be applicable.

1. Further, to assess the available facilities of teaching, non-teaching, hospital staff, practical training and other infrastructure facilities at your college namely to National Institute of Ayurveda, (Deemed to be University), Madhav Vilas Palace Amer Road, Jaipur-302002, Rajasthan, (Inst. ID-AYU0225), inspection of your College was conducted on 19.02.2024 & 20.02.2024 in Hybrid mode as a part of annual visitation by the visitation team of Medical Assessment and Rating Board, NCISM to process the Conditional Permission with 100 seats (125 seats including EWS) in UG (BAMS) Course and 104 Seats (130 seats including EWS) in 14 PG Course namely i). Agad Tantra avum Vidhi Vaidyaka- 06 seats (07 seats including EWS), ii). Prasuti & Stri Roga-07 seats (09 seats including EWS), iii). Dravyaguna Vigyana-09 seats (11 seats including EWS), iv). Kaumarbhritiya - Bala Roga- 07 seats (08 seats including EWS), v). Kayachikitsa-09 seats (11 seats including EWS), vi). Kriya Sharir-08 seats (10 seats including EWS), vii). Panchakarma-07 seats (08 seats including EWS), viii). Rasa Shastra & Bhaisajya Kalpana-08 seats (10 seats including EWS), ix). Rachna Sharir-07 seats (09 seats including EWS), x). Ayurved Samhita, Sanskrit & Siddanta-08 seats (10 seats including EWS), xi). Rog Nidan avum Vikriti Vigyan-08 seats (11 seats including EWS), xii). Swasthavritta-07 seats (09 seats including EWS), xiii). Shalaky-06 seats (08 seats including EWS) and xiv). Shalya Tantra-07 seats (09 seats including EWS), under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2024-25.
2. Further, the visitation report and all other related documents were assessed in terms of the enforced regulations namely, the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016", Indian Medicine Central Council (Post-graduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations, 2016", provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations there under.

3. Thereafter, the assessment report was placed in the 96<sup>th</sup> Board meeting of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) held on 05.07.2024. On careful examination of the assessment report it is found that your college is not fulfilling the notified & approved criteria, due to the following shortcoming:

**1. Non-teaching staff: -**

a) Availability of Non-Teaching staff is  $\frac{\text{Available}}{\text{Required}} \times 100\% = \frac{41}{43} \times 100\% = 95.34\%$

**2. Hospital staffs:**

a) Availability of Hospital staff is  $\frac{\text{Available}}{\text{Required}} \times 100\% = \frac{106}{109} \times 100\% = 97.24\%$

4. However, as per regulation 3(3) (a) of MSR, 2016, the college is fulfilling the basic eligibility criteria for conditional permission for the academic year 2024-25. Hence the Board decided to issue the Conditional Permission with with 100 seats (125 seats including EWS) in UG (BAMS) Course and 104 Seats (130 seats including EWS) in 14 PG Course namely i). Agad Tantra avum Vidhi Vaidyaka- 06 seats (07 seats including EWS), ii). Prasuti & Stri Roga-07 seats (09 seats including EWS), iii). Dravyaguna Vigyana-09 seats (11 seats including EWS), iv). Kaumarbhritiya - Bala Roga- 07 seats (08 seats including EWS), v). Kayachikitsa-09 seats (11 seats including EWS), vi). Kriya Sharir-08 seats (10 seats including EWS), vii). Panchakarma-07 seats (08 seats including EWS), viii). Rasa Shastra & Bhaisajya Kalpana-08 seats (10 seats including EWS), ix). Rachna Sharir-07 seats (09 seats including EWS), x). Ayurved Samhita, Sanskrit & Siddanta-08 seats (10 seats including EWS), xi). Rog Nidan avum Vikriti Vigyan-08 seats (11 seats including EWS), xii). Swasthavritta-07 seats (09 seats including EWS), xiii). Shalaky-06 seats (08 seats including EWS) and xiv). 5. Therefore, conditional permission is granted to National Institute of Ayurveda, (Deemed to be University), Madhav Vilas Palace Amer Road, Jaipur-302002, Rajasthan, (Inst. ID-AYU0225) with with 100 seats (125 seats including EWS) in UG (BAMS) Course and 104 Seats (130 seats including EWS) in 14 PG Course namely i). Agad Tantra avum Vidhi Vaidyaka- 06 seats (07 seats including EWS), ii). Prasuti & Stri Roga-07 seats (09 seats including EWS), iii). Dravyaguna Vigyana-09 seats (11 seats including EWS), iv). Kaumarbhritiya - Bala Roga- 07 seats (08 seats including EWS), v). Kayachikitsa-09 seats (11 seats including EWS), vi). Kriya Sharir-08 seats (10 seats including EWS), vii). Panchakarma-07 seats (08 seats including EWS), viii). Rasa Shastra & Bhaisajya Kalpana-08 seats (10 seats including EWS), ix). Rachna Sharir-07 seats (09 seats including EWS), x). Shalya Tantra-07 seats (09 seats including EWS), under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2024-25 subject to the condition that college is fulfilling the following requirements: -
- I. It is further informed that 100% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity with 125 seats (Including EWS) Shall be treated as all India quota and with reference letter no. F.1/(340/PG/ACA/2021-2022 dated 08.11.2021 the matter related to 130 PG seats (Including EWS) was placed before NCISM in its meeting held on 16.11.2021 and it was decided by the Commission that National Institute of Ayurveda comes under the De-Novo category which is different than the deemed to be university category as per UGC norms/regulation. Hence NCISM allowed the existing seat matrix and quota for 130 PG seats (Including EWS) for the admission in National Institute of Ayurveda, (Deemed to be University), Jaipur, Rajasthan. The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government/NCISM for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.
6. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under NCISM Act & Regulations thereunder.
7. Further, as per Sub-section (7) of Section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020, the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine may conduct evaluation and assessment of any University or medical institution at any time, either directly or through any other expert, having integrity and experience in medical profession, without any prior notice and assess and evaluate the performance, standards and benchmarks of such University or medical institution and if the college is found to be not maintaining the Minimum Essential standards as specified in the concerned Acts & Regulations then in accordance of Section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act, 2020 the issued permission of the college shall deemed to be withdrawn and denial of permission shall be issued by MARBISM for stoppage of admission for that particular academic year or the subsequent year.

8. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM.
9. The following requirements should be fulfilled by the college by 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2024 and compliance report should be sent to get permission for the academic session 2025-2026:
- All the requirements under the provisions of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled in toto
  - All the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in the NCISM (Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for undergraduate Ayurveda colleges and attached teaching hospitals) Regulations, 2024.
  - All the requirements of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Standards of Undergraduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations, 2022;
  - All the requirements of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Postgraduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations, 2016;
  - The shortcoming mentioned in Point no. 3 above, should be fulfilled.
10. The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college to President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled for considering the permission for the academic session 2025-26.
