Subject:- Grant of Conditional Permission to National Institute of Ayurveda, Madhav Vilas Palace Amer Road, Jaipur-302002, Rajasthan (Inst. ID-AYU0225) for intake capacity with 100 seats (125 seats including EWS) in UG (BAMS) course and 104 seats (130 seats including EWS) in 14 PG courses namely (i) Kaya Chikitsa - 09 seats (11 seats including EWS) (ii) Prasuti evam Stri Roga- 07 seats (09 seats including EWS) (iii) Shalya Tantra -07 seats (09 seats including EWS) (iv) Shalakya - 06 Seats (08 seats including EWS) (v) Panchkarma - 07 Seats (08 seats including EWS) (vi) Dravyaguna Vigyan-09 seats (11 seats including EWS) (vii) Rasa Shastra & Bhaishajya Kalpana- 08 seats (10 seats including EWS) (viii) Rog Nidan evam Vikriti Vigyan - 08 Seats (11 seats including EWS) (ix) Swasthviritta and Yoga - 07 Seats (09 seats including EWS) (x) Ayurved Samhita evam Siddhant - 08 seats (10 Seats including EWS) (xi) Kriya Sharir - 08 seats (10 seats including EWS) (xii) Kaumarabhritya - 07 seats (08 seats including EWS) (xiii) Rachna sharir- 07 seats (09 seats including EWS) and (xiv) Agad Tantra Evam Vidhi Vaidyaka - 06 seats (07 seats including EWS) for the academic session 2023-24 under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder-reg.

Sir/Madam,

With reference to the subject mentioned above, I am directed to inform you that in pursuance of the provision of National commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020, the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) has been repealed with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021. With effect from the said date, the Central Council of Indian Medicine constituted under sub-division (1) of section 3 of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) shall stand dissolved. Now, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (3) of the section 1 of the said Act, the Central Government hereby notifies that all the provisions of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020 has been come into force with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021 and as per regulation 59 (2) of The National Commission for Indian System of Medicine ACT, 2020, Medical standards, requirements and other provisions of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 and the rules and regulations made there under shall continue to be in force and operate till new standards or requirements are specified under this Act or the rules and regulations made there under.

Further, the provision of concerned regulations which are inconsistent with the provision of NCISM Act, 2020 shall not be applicable.

1. Further, to assess the available facilities of teaching, non-teaching, Hospital staff, practical training and other infrastructure facilities at your college namely **National Institute of Ayurveda, (Deemed to be University), Madhav Vilas Palace Amer Road, Jaipur-302002, Rajasthan (Inst. ID-AYU0225)** inspection of your College was conducted on **18.05.2023 and 19.05.2023** on hybrid mode as a part of annual visitation by the visitation team of Medical Assessment and Rating Board, NCISM to process the conditional permission for intake capacity with 100 seats (125 seats including EWS) in UG (BAMS) course and 104 seats (130 seats including EWS) in 14 PG courses namely (i) Kaya Chikitsa - 09 seats (11 seats including EWS) (ii) Prasuti evam Stri Rog- 07 seats (09 seats including EWS) (iii) Shalya Tantra -07 seats (09 seats including EWS) (iv) Shalakya - 06 seats (08 seats including EWS) (v) Panchkarma - 07 seats (08 seats including EWS) (vi) Dravyaguna Vigyan-09 seats (11 seats including EWS) (vii) Rasa Shastra & Bhaishajya Kalpana- 08 seats (10 seats including EWS) (viii) Rog Nidan evam Vikriti Vigyan - 08 Seats (11 seats including EWS) (ix) Swasthviritta and Yoga - 07 seats (09 seats including EWS) (x) Ayurved Samhita evam Siddhant - 08 seats (10 seats including EWS) (xi) Kriya Sharir - 08 seats (10 seats including EWS) (xii) Kaumarabhritya - 07 seats (08 seats including EWS) (xiii) Rachna sharir- 07 seats (09 seats including EWS) (xiv) Agad Tantra Evam Vidhi Vaidyaka - 06 seats (07 seats including EWS) under Section 28 of NCISM Act 2020 for the academic session 2023-24.
2. Further, the visitation report and all other related documents were assessed in terms of the enforced regulations namely, the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016", All the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Post Graduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations, 2016 and provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations there under.
3. As per the direction of President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM), the assessment report was placed in the **44th Board meeting** of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) held on **23.06.2023**. On careful examination of the assessment report it is found that **your college is not fulfilling the teacher student ratio for PG in the department of Kriya sharir. Hence Board decided to ask clarification for the college regarding shortcoming in Kriya Sharir department.** There after a letter was issued for clarification regarding the same vide letter with even number dated **08.07.2023**. Further Board was in receipt of the clarification letter vide reference number **9(4)NCISM/Aca./2023-24** dated **14.07.2023**.

4. Therefore as per the direction from President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board, after examining the submitted clarification Conditional Permission is granted to National Institute of Ayurveda, (Deemed to be University), Madhav Vilas Palace Amer Road, Jaipur-302002, Rajasthan (Inst. ID-AYU0225) for intake capacity with 100 seats (125 seats including EWS) in UG (BAMS) course and 104 seats (130 seats including EWS) in 14 PG courses namely (i) Kaya Chikitsa - 09 seats (11 seats including EWS) (ii) Prasuti evam Stri Rog- 07 seats (09 seats including EWS) (iii) Shalya Tantra - 07 seats (09 seats including EWS) (iv) Shalakya - 06 seats (08 seats including EWS) (v) Panchkarma - 07 seats (08 seats including EWS) (vi) Dravyaguna Vigyan-09 seats (11 seats including EWS) (vii) Rasa Shastra & Bhaishajya Kalpana- 08 seats (10 seats including EWS) (viii) Rog Nidan evam Vikriti Vigyan - 08 Seats (11 seats including EWS) (ix) Swasthvritta and Yoga - 07 seats (09 seats including EWS) (x) Ayurved Samhita evam Siddhant - 08 seats (10 seats including EWS) (xi) Kriya Sharir - 08 seats (10 seats including EWS) (xii) Kaumarabhritya - 07 seats (08 seats including EWS) (xiii) Rachna sharir- 07 seats (09 seats including EWS) (xiv) Agad Tantra Evam Vidhi Vaidyaka - 06 seats (07 seats including EWS) for the academic session 2023-24, under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020, subject to the condition that college is fulfilling the following requirements:-

- i) It is further informed that 100% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity of 125 seats (including EWS) shall be treated as all India quota and with reference letter no. F.1/(340/PG/ACA/2021-2022 dated 08.11.2021 the matter related to 130 PG seats (including EWS) was placed before NCISM in its meeting held on 16.11.2021 and it was decided by the Commission that National Institute of Ayurveda comes under the De-Novo category which is different than the deemed to be university category as per UGC norms/regulation. Hence NCISM allowed the existing seat matrix and quota for 130 PG seats (including EWS) for the admission in National Institute of Ayurveda, (Deemed to be University), Jaipur, Rajasthan. The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government/NCISM for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.
5. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under NCISM Act & Regulations thereunder.
 6. Further, as per Sub-section (7) of Section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020, The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine may conduct evaluation and assessment of any University or medical institution at any time, either directly or through any other expert, having integrity and experience in medical profession, without any prior notice and assess and evaluate the performance, standards and benchmarks of such University or medical institution and if the college is found to be not maintaining the Minimum Essential standards as specified in the concerned Acts & Regulations then in accordance of Section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act, 2020 the issued permission of the college shall deemed to be withdrawn and denial of permission shall be issued by MARBISM for stoppage of admission for that particular or the subsequent academic year.
 7. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM.
 8. The following requirements should be fulfilled by the college by 31st December, 2023 and send a compliance report to get permission for the session 2024-25:-
 - i) all the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016;
 - ii) all the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Post Graduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations, 2016
 - iii) all the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standards of Education in Indian Medicine) Amendment Regulations, 2016 (for Ayurveda);
 - iv) all the requirements under the provisions of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled in totol; and
 9. The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college to President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled for considering the permission for the academic session 2024-25.
