



Agenda Item No. AC. 12.1	Confirmation of the Minutes of 11th Academic Council Meeting held on 30th September 2025.

Agenda Item No. AC.12.2	Action Taken Report of the 11th Meeting of Academic Council.
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The Academic Council took note of the Action Taken and the present status report on the agenda items discussed in its 11th Meeting. The Academic Council discussed & reviewed the Action Taken Report thoroughly on the current implementation status of all agenda items one by one.

For Agenda No. AC. 11.20, the chairperson suggested to include Prof. Uday Raj Saroj & Prof. Rakesh Nagar as members in the committee to be constituted to frame draft of Roles and Responsibilities for Faculty members.

Agenda Item No. AC. 12.3	Update on Admission Status for the Academic Session 2025-26 at NIA, Jaipur and NIA, Panchkula
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The Academic Council noted the status of admissions to the various programmes for academic session 2025-26 at NIA, Jaipur and NIA, Panchkula.

The chairperson directed the Central Admission Board to remain updated about the upcoming schedules to fill the seats remained vacant even after the Stray Vacancy Round of AACCC Counselling at Institution level as per the directions of NCISM.

Agenda Item No. AC.12.4	Ratification of the Academic Calendar for M.Sc. (IDS) Batch 2025
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The Academic Council ratified the Academic Calendar as recommended by the respective BoS of IDS programme for the M.Sc. Batch 2025-26.

Agenda Item No. AC. 12.5	Ratification of Timetable for Common Classes – M.Sc. (IDS) Batch 2025
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The Academic Council ratified the Timetable as recommended by the BoS of IDS programme for the common classes of M.Sc. Batch 2025-26.

Agenda Item No. AC. 12.6	Adoption of the Revised PG Ayurveda Syllabus for 3rd to 6th Semester circulated by NCISM
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The Academic Council noted the adoption of the revised syllabus of PG Ayurveda (MD/MS) 3rd to 6th semester issued by the BoA (Board of Ayurveda), NCISM in compliance of NCISM competency based dynamic curriculum and syllabus for successful implementation.

Agenda Item No. AC.12.7	Adoption of the guideline from the NCISM for the completion of electives for 2024-25 Batch
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The Academic Council noted the adoption of the guideline issued by the BoA (Board of Ayurveda), NCISM that provided the provision of completion of 12 elective courses within the entire 6 semesters/3 years applicable only to the PG Ayurveda (MD/MS) Batch 2024-2025.



Agenda Item No. AC.12.8	Adoption of the guideline for the Online Viva-Voce of Ph.D. Program issued by the UGC.
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After a thorough discussion on key highlights, the Academic Council reviewed and principally agreed the adoption of the guideline from UGC Gazette Notification No.544 (Part III- Section 4) (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2022 Clause 11 & Sub clause 5 for the inclusion of the option to conduct Viva-voce examination Online in addition to the existing offline mode for Ph.D. Program.

Agenda Item No. AC.12.9	Approval of Updated Guidelines of Educational Tours for UG, PG & Ph.D. Programs.
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The Academic Council reviewed and approved the Guidelines for Participation of Undergraduate (UG) and Postgraduate (PG) Scholars in Educational Tours, as recommended by the duly constituted committee.

For UG Programme, It was also decided that there should be two tours 1 local (within rajasthan) & 1 outside rajasthan (within India) in the professional where it has been prescribed in the syllabus.

For PG Programme, 1 tour for each department may be allowed with proper justification.

The council had not permitted the provision of Education Tour for Ph.D. Programme.

It was directed that these provisions be formally incorporated into the rules and regulations governing UG and PG programmes.

Agenda Item No. AC. 12.10	Approval of Revised Faculty Eligibility Criteria for the M.Sc. IDS Programme
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The Academic Council approved the proposed modifications for revised Faculty eligibility criteria.

However, for further inclusion of the faculty from other subjects, it was recommended to constitute a committee to review, determine and finalize the revised eligibility criteria for the posts of faculty members under the interdisciplinary studies. The constituted committee will ensure the Revised Faculty Eligibility Criteria to be in alignment with current and emerging domain-specific requirements in adherence to the standards and mandates set forth by the National Institute of Ayurveda and the regulatory bodies governing higher education and Ayurvedic studies.



Agenda Item No. AC. 12.11	Approval of Guidelines for Supervising PG Research Work During Guide or Co-Guide Deputation, Sabbatical, or Extended Leave.
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The Academic Council reviewed and approved the Guidelines for Supervising PG Research Work in absence of Guide as recommended by the committee constituted for this purpose to ensure the uninterrupted continuity and quality of research work and prevent delays in thesis submission caused by absence of guide.

It was also directed that these provisions be formally incorporated into the rules and regulations governing both PG and Ph.D. programmes.

Agenda Item No. AC. 12.12	Approval of Mandatory Pre-requisites for Eligibility to appear in the Second Term (2nd Summative) Examination for PG Students
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The Academic council **turned down** the proposal made by the BoS (PG) Programme.

After a thorough review, the Academic Council was of the opinion that before appearing for the third summative assessment at the end of the sixth semester the student shall have to pass all core subjects of the first and second semesters of the Postgraduate Degree programme.

The failed students from first summative or second summative or from both the summative has to appear for subsequent examinations conducted every six months by the University as per clause 22 (Examination and assessment) Subclause 5 & 14 of the Guidelines issued by the NCISM (Minimum Essential Standards, Assessment and Rating for Postgraduate Institutions and Minimum Standards for Postgraduate Education in Ayurveda) Regulations, 2024 on 1st October, 2024.

The maximum duration for completion of M.D./M.S -Ayurveda course shall not exceed 6 Years as per Clause -20(4) - Duration of course and attendance.

Agenda Item No. AC. 12.13	Approval of Guidelines for Mandatory Brief Thesis Outcome Presentation for PG Final Year Scholars
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The Academic Council discussed & reviewed the proposal and decided to drop the agenda item on the grounds of non-feasibility.

Agenda Item No. AC. 12.14	To Approve the Proposed IPR Credit Based Advanced Certificate course for PG & Ph.D. Students
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The Academic Council approved the 4-credit based Advanced Certificate Course on Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) for PG & Ph.D. scholars to encourage integrating IPR awareness into mainstream education.

Agenda Item No. AC. 12.15	Approval of the Format of Mark sheet for 2nd Term PG Examination
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The Academic Council considered and approved the Format of 2nd Semester Mark-sheet which clearly show distinct evaluation categories, with separate sections for the distribution of theory and practical marks for PG Batch 2024-25 and onwards.

Agenda Item No. AC. 12.16	Approval for Issuing Secure, Tear-Resistant Coloured Mark Sheets with Added Features from the 2024-2025 Session
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The Academic Council considered and approved the proposal to issue tear-resistant, coloured paper Mark Sheets from the session 2024-25 onwards applicable to all Programmes offered by the Institute.

Agenda Item No. AC. 12.17	Approval of SOP for University Examination Question Paper Setting and Use without Moderation
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The Academic Council considered and approved the proposal to standardize the examination process by setting question papers directly without subsequent moderation to ensure quality, maintaining confidentiality and to reduce administrative delays. It was also decided to have a pilot observation in regard to this before final approval.

Agenda Item No. AC. 12.18	Approval of the Amendments to the Rules & Regulation for the Ph.D. Programme
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The Academic Council after thorough comparative discussions on key highlights of existing and amended rules reviewed and considered the proposed amendments in the Rules & Regulation for Ayurveda Vidhyavaridhi (Ph.D. - Ayurveda) Program effective from the date of notification in compliance with the guidelines of UGC. Following recommendations were suggested accordingly:

Clause No./Existing Rule	Proposed Amendment	Recommendation
7.3.1(b) Regarding calculation of tenure of Ph.D. The duration shall be calculated from the date of deposition of fees by the candidate at the time of admission.	Tenure of regular Ph.D. scholars shall be calculated from the date of joining in the department .The commencement of the session should be only after deposition of the fees by the scholars that means prior to 1 st july. The BOS suggested to draft SOP's regarding fee submission.	Approved Commencing the session on 1 st July, will help in maintaining administrative clarity and academic discipline. This practice will ensure that all registered scholars begin the session simultaneously, promoting uniformity, avoiding procedural delays, and supporting smooth academic operations.



10.3- Regarding terminology of On Duty Leave On Duty Leave (ODL)- Fifteen days (15) Duty leave/Special leave shall be granted to the scholar who shall be deputed or allowed by the authority to take part in the sports/seminar/workshop/academic activities.	BOS recommended the term "Academic Leave" instead of "On Duty Leave" for all related communications.	Approved The revised term "Academic Leave" instead of "On Duty Leave" clearly indicates that the leave pertains to academic engagements such as conferences, workshops, fieldwork, and research-related duties.
14.2.1.4 Regarding Course work evaluation The course work shall be examined by internal evaluation of 40% weightage and end-term evaluation of 60% weightage.	The BOS recommended changing the internal evaluation of 40% weightage to 50% and end-term evaluation of 50% weightage instead of 60%.	Not approved The AC recommended following the existing guidelines of internal evaluation of 40% weightage and end-term evaluation of 60% weightage.
15.1- Regarding Swayam Portal online courses The research scholar will be required to complete 3 online courses offered on the Swayam Portal (Duration of individual course) along with their regular curriculum mandatorily during the program's duration failing which their thesis will not be accepted.	Area of concerned course should be chosen through supervisor and the same should be communicated to Dean Ph.D. through proper channel.	Approved The amendment that the SWAYAM portal course's area of concern to be selected by the supervisor ensuring that the chosen course is directly aligned with the scholar's research focus and academic needs with minimum duration of 4 weeks.
26.4- Regarding duration of thesis evaluation by external examiner In the event of the thesis report not being received from an examiner within a period of two months, the Controller of examination may seek approval of Vice Chancellor for appointment of another examiner.	The BOS recommended for the appointment of alternate examiner after 1 month. The BOS suggested to draft SOP's regarding thesis evaluation.	Not approved Academic Council was of the opinion that an effective communication made to the external examiner can be a valid solution to check the delay in the thesis evaluation.

Agenda Item	Approval of Duration of SWAYAM Portal courses for Scholars
No. AC. 12.20	enrolled in the Ph.D. Programme

Academic Council principally approved that the decision regarding the duration of the SWAYAM Portal courses will be at the discretion of the Guide with detailed communication made to the office of the Dean Ph. D. studies, with minimum duration of 4 weeks.
