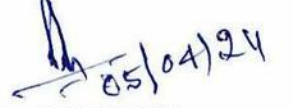

After that, with the permission of the Chairperson, Dr. Narinder Singh, Joint Registrar (Academic), on behalf of Prof. Aku Rama Murthy (Member secretary), presented the agenda Items one by one for discussion and consideration.

Agenda Item No. AC. 6.1 Confirmation of the minutes of the meeting of the 5th Academic Council.

As there was no observation received on the circulated minutes hence, the Academic Council confirmed the Minutes of its 5th Meeting held on Nov. 22nd, 2023.

Agenda Item No. AC. 6.2 Reviews of the Action Taken Report of the 5th Academic Council.

Academic Council noted the Action Taken/Present Position on the Minutes of its 5th Meeting held on Nov. 22nd, 2023.

Agenda Item No. AC. 6.3 Information about the list of the students enrolled for admission to 1st Year for the UG (BAMS) & PG (MD/MS) program for Batch 2023-2024.

The Academic Council noted the list of the students enrolled for admission to 1st Year for the UG (BAMS) & PG (MD/MS) program in NIA Jaipur DU under the De-Novo category for session 2023-2024.

Agenda Item No. AC. 6.4 Ratification of Academic Calendar for the UG program (BAMS) for 1st & 2nd Year batches for the respective Academic sessions.



The Academic Council reviewed & ratified the Academic Calendar for the Ist & IInd Year batches for the UG program (BAMS) for the respective Academic sessions.

Agenda Item No. AC. 6.5 **Review of the Proposal To make amendments to the Existing Migration Policy for admission against the vacant seats.**

After a detailed discussion over the existing Migration Policy in the Academic Council, it was decided that for migration against the vacant seats, the seat allocation must be done as per respective category & the unfilled seats are to be filled under the UR category following the existing approved migration policy. As the candidates (under consideration for the migration to the second year) had already availed of the benefits of the reservation at the time of counselling & admission to the first year, so to ensure justification and legality in the seat allocation process, it was unanimously decided to refer the matter for a legal opinion. This was also decided that the finalized & approved draft of the Migration policy must be made available for referral before admission notification for the next session under migration against the vacant seats.

Agenda Item No. AC. 6.6 **Proposal to frame Uniform and Standard guidelines and Timely mechanism for Guide allocation for PG/Ph.D. and IDS (M. Sc) Program.**

To ensure the consistency and efficiency in the allocation of Supervisors/Guides for students pursuing Ph.D. /P. G and IDS (M. Sc) programs, a proposal to establish uniform and standard guidelines, and a timely mechanism was accepted.

It was unanimously accepted that establishing clear guidelines and mechanisms can help streamline the process and ensure that students receive adequate support and guidance throughout their academic journey. The academic council suggested framing an appropriate committee comprising the representations from all the sections of faculty members & teacher association to frame the draft for this and get it approved by the competent authority.

Agenda Item No. AC. 6.7 **Review and approval of the format for submitting the synopsis for the PG Program.**

As a significant step forward in streamlining the process of submitting the synopsis (research protocol) for the PG program standardized format will ensure more clarity and consistency. The Academic Council concluded that it will also help students & respective bodies for the timely accomplishment of the approvals from DRC, IRRB, IAC & IAAC.



As a commitment to maintaining high standards and supporting students in their academic pursuits, the Academic Council reviewed & approved the format recommended by the BOS (PG) for submitting the synopsis for the PG Program.

Agenda Item No. AC. 6.8 Review and approval of the list of the Eligible Supervisors for Ph.D. program & Guides PG Program.

Currently, Dr. Vipin Kumar & Dr. Deshmukh Prashant Naresh Rao were not found eligible to be the Supervisors for the Ph.D. program. The Academic Council reviewed & approved the list of the Eligible Supervisors for Ph.D. Program & Guides for the PG Program as per the ordinances of P.G. & Ph.D. of NIA.

Agenda Item No. AC. 6.9 Review and approval of the proposal of framing the research advisory committee as a sub-committee of IRRB to review various Academic and Research Progress of Ph.D. scholars.

The Chairperson IRRB informed that the IRRB already has a provision about this, so the Academic Council suggested to withdraw this Agenda Item.

Agenda Item No. AC. 6.10 Review and approval of the Fees Refund Policy Adopted from UGC recommended by the BOS (IDS program).

The Academic Council was informed that the draft of the fee refund policy as per the guidelines of UGC has already been forwarded to the finance committee for review & approval. The Academic Council reviewed & approved the proposal for the Fees Refund Policy adopted from UGC recommended by the BOS (IDS program) after getting its approval from the Finance committee.

Agenda Item No. AC. 6.11 Ratification of the Academic Time Table & Academic Calendar for the IDS program) for M.Sc. Courses 1st Year (session 2023-2024) & IInd Year (session 2022-2023).

The Academic Council reviewed & ratified the Academic Time Table & Academic Calendar for the IDS program) for M.Sc. Courses 1st Year (Session 2023-2024) & IInd Year (Session 2022-2023).

Agenda Item No. AC. 6.12 Review and approval of the amended plan for the Six-month internship for the Para-Medical (DAN & P) program.

The Academic Council reviewed & approved the amended plan recommended by the BOS (Nursing) for the Six-month internship for Para-Medical (DAN & P) program.



Agenda Item No. AC. 6.13 Stipends rules for In-Services Candidates enrolled under the PG Program in NIA Jaipur.

After a detailed discussion, to prevent any financial discrepancy about the Stipend rules for In-Services Candidates enrolled under the PG Program in NIA Jaipur the Academic Council unanimously suggested adopting a procedure regarding further review & deciding accordingly comprising:

1. Writing a letter to the Director of Ayurveda Rajasthan seeking detailed information about the pay rules for the in-service candidates enrolled under the PG Program during their Academic leave to pursue the PG Program.
2. After getting the information refer the matter to the finance committee for further review and approval.

Agenda Item No. AC. 6.14 To review and approve the eligibility criteria for admission under Vrikshayurveda (M.Sc. IDS program)/amendment made in the Syllabus of Vrikshayurveda (M.Sc. IDS program).

The Academic Council reviewed & approved the eligibility criteria for admission under Vrikshayurveda (M.Sc. IDS program with the eligibility for the graduates from Ayurveda (BAMS), B.Sc.(Horticulture), B.Sc. (Forestry), B.Sc. (Agriculture) & B.Sc. Hons. (Botany) only & removing the clause of eligibility for science Graduates (any stream).

To make the curricular contents more practical & career-oriented, the Academic Council reviewed & approved amendments recommended by the BOS (IDS Program) in the Syllabus of Vrikshayurveda (M.Sc. IDS program).
