

Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor Prof. Sanjeev Sharma, Chairperson of the Academic Council, formally welcomed all the members of the reconstituted Academic council constituted as per the guidelines of the approved MOA. After this Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor provided a brief of the ongoing developments within the Institute & NIA Panchkula. The Chairperson insisted that members are welcomed to offer suggestions beyond the agenda items of the meeting. The Chairperson asked the Deans and HoDs to ensure the implementation of the approved Agenda Items to achieve the desired objective.



Besides, he also discussed with the member Secretary, Academic Council to convene a meeting with the Deans & stakeholders to be presided over by him to evaluate the actual implementation status of all agenda items approved in earlier meeting of Academic Council to address compliance related discrepancies. He also suggested constituting a **Prospectus Committee** comprising of the Deans to design prospectus for all the programmes being undertaken by the university in accordance to the updated guidelines, rules & regulations. The Academic Council agreed to incorporate the suggestions.

Following that, with the Chairperson's permission, Prof. Narinder Singh, Joint Registrar (Academic), presented the agenda items for discussion and consideration on behalf of Prof. Anita Sharma, Registrar I/C and Secretary, Academic Council.

**Agenda Item No. AC. 9.1: Confirmation of the minutes of the meeting of the 8<sup>th</sup> Academic Council.**

It was conveyed to the Academic council that the observations received on the circulated minutes were already incorporated hence, after a thorough review, the Academic Council confirmed the Minutes of its 8<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on 30<sup>th</sup> Jan., 2025.

The Chairperson suggested to use the bilingual format comprising Hindi & English for drafting the Notices, Agenda Notes, Minutes, ATR of the upcoming meetings of Academic Council & other official works to promote the use of Hindi as per directions of Dept. of Official Language, Govt. of India. The Chairperson also suggested the office for the segregation of items in the different sections according to their nature (for adoption/ratification/noting/approval/discussion/forwarding to finance committee etc.) to enhance the clarity of the Agenda Notes for the effective discussion. The Academic Council agreed to incorporate the suggestions.

**Agenda Item No. AC. 9.2 : To note down the Action Taken Report of the 8<sup>th</sup> Academic Council.**

The Academic Council noted the Action Taken and the present status report on the agenda items discussed in its 8<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on 30<sup>th</sup> Jan., 2025.

The Academic Council discussed & reviewed the Action Taken Report thoroughly on the current implementation status. The Chairperson re-emphasized on the necessity to prioritize ATR implementation to the concerned authorities. The Academic Council agreed to incorporate the suggestions.

**Agenda Item No. AC. 9.3: To inform the Academic council about the Notification of competence based medical education/Objective based medical education (CBME/OBME) subjects of 3<sup>rd</sup> Professional BAMS Course by the NCISM.**

The Academic Council noted & approved the adoption of the revised syllabus of all subjects of 3<sup>rd</sup> Professional BAMS course as per the notification made by the NCISM. The council suggested to strictly comply with the NCISM guidelines for the Implementation of competence based medical education/Objective based medical education (CBME/OBME) syllabus & make the amendments in the Academic Calendars accordingly.



**Agenda Item No.AC.9.4 To inform the Academic council about the Gazette notification No. 771 dated October 01, 2024/ASVINA 12,1996 of NCISM in regards to Constitution of the Institute Research committees & notification of subject wise Areas of Research.**

The Academic Council was informed about the on-going progress & prompt compliance on the renaming the IRRB as the Institute Research committees & to make the directed amendments in its constitution as per the Gazette notification of NCISM. The Academic council also noted the subject wise Areas of Research of the PG Programme.

**Agenda Item No. AC. 9.5 To inform the Academic council about the appointment of Deans, Associate Deans and In-Charges of the Controller of Examination & Dy. Controller of Examination.**

The Academic Council acknowledged the recent appointments of Deans, Associate Deans, and In-Charges of the Controller of Examination and Deputy Controller of Examination. These appointments are pivotal in designing and actively implementing policies that are aimed at improving the academic environment at the university. This also shows a clear step towards enhancing academic governance and ensuring that the university's academic processes and policies are continuously evolving.

#### **Additional Agenda**

**Agenda Item No. AC. 9.6 To inform the Academic council about the Notification of New PG Program Structure; 'Implementation of Outcome-Based Dynamic Curriculum for Research Methodology & Biostatistics' by NCISM.**

The Academic Council noted the adoption of 'Outcome-Based Dynamic Curriculum for Research Methodology & Biostatistics' for PG program. The council suggested strictly complying with the NCISM guidelines for the Implementation of OBDC of Research Methodology and Biostatistics and making amendments in the Academic Calendars accordingly.

The Controller of Examination highlighted a major concern about the need of framing the fixed Schedule of Examinations for the University. He also urged the concerned stakeholders to streamline the Academic calendars accordingly, which will allow the COE Section to make advance arrangements & manage workload effectively.

#### **Suggestions by the Prof. (Dr.) Mahesh Dixit:**


To enhance the Academic Atmosphere in the University Prof. Mahesh Dixit suggested to arrange Teacher-Students interaction programmes on a regular manner. These sessions can provide students with an opportunity to ask questions, clarify doubts, and deepen their understanding of topics they may have struggled with during regular classes. Such interactions can be highly beneficial as these may strengthen the objectives like



personalized, interactive learning, improved conceptual clarity, developing & strengthening the Student Teacher Relationships.

Besides, he also shared the two active programmes named "Sadhguna Parayan" ("सद्गुण परायण") & "Shishyopnishada" on-going at Govt. Ayurvedic College, Udaipur which focuses on fostering ethical values like (integrity, empathy, respect etc.) in students through education, aiming to develop responsible citizens with strong moral foundations as per NEP 2020. The Academic Council agreed to incorporate his suggestions and directed to create an action plan for its implementation.
